

Adara Goldberg Holocaust Survivors in Canada

After WWII 35,000 Jewish Holocaust survivors arrived in Canada. The unprecedented scale of the relief effort required for the survivors challenged both the established Jewish community and resettlement agents alike. Survivors in Canada represents the first comprehensive analysis of the resettlement, integration, and acculturation experience of survivors in early postwar Canada.
